Leonteios School (Lycée Léonin) is one of the most historical non-profit private schools in Greece. Founded in 1889, it has two campuses in Athens and **offers programs ranging from Nursery to High School**. CHALLENGES

As a **multi-level school** with Nursery, two elementary and secondary schools, Leonteios faced serious challenges managing academic data with its previous system.

The main objective in the research for a new Student Information system was to **digitalize the processes for academic, financial, admission, transportation, and library management**.

Also, school management wanted to **provide teachers with an easy-to-use platform** that would help them streamline timetable creation, attendance tracking, and marking processes.
